This position requires an experienced, dedicated professional with a background in financial management, as you will be accountable for diversifying revenue streams by actively seeking and securing new funding sources and developing a fundraising strategy. Fundraising experience and proposal writing are strong assets. You will possess superior networking skills with the ability to build and sustain partnerships while raising the community profile of Tamara's House. Although this position is responsible for the daily and financial management of the organization, you will work closely with survivors and assist with program development and clinical supervision, thus an understanding of survivor issues is desired. Applicants with clinical experience are preferred, however those without clinical experience but significant management experience will also be considered. You possess strong cross-cultural awareness and embrace diversity, and have experience with conflict resolution and crisis management.

Qualifications:

Degree in the Human Services field and/or Business Administration. Applicants with a Masters Degree will be given preference. A number of years of management experience is also preferred. Only female applicants will be considered (Human Rights Exemption #E98-18).
